## ANNUAL REPORT 2020

To our member-owners of Downeast Credit Union:

Thank you to Downeast Credit Union's 22,108 memberowners for your ongoing support and participation in our financial cooperative. We were able to pool our savings and lend them to members of our community to help them buy homes, cars, pay for college, and do a variety of other things, thereby creating opportunities. During 2020, your credit union made over 4,000 loans totaling over \$66 million.

Throughout the difficult pandemic, your credit union navigated well, continuing to serve you, our member. We were able to keep our branch lobbies open, follow strict CDC operating guidelines to keep you and our Team safe, and provide our members with the financial resources they needed to succeed.

We strategically increased our net worth from 8.42 percent to 9.02 percent, which our federal regulators consider to be well capitalized. Operating costs fell from \$11.2 million to \$10.0 million. The total value of assets under management has risen from \$203 million to \$222 million.

Your Board of Directors and management team are committed to maintaining a vibrant workplace environment. Downeast was named a Best Place to Work in Maine company for the fourth year in a row in 2020. Excellent member service, we believe, begins with employers providing an exceptional working environment.
