TO OUR MEMBER OWNERS:

Your member-owned credit union is grateful for your support. The principle objective of your Board of Directors, Leadership Team, and Team Members has always been to provide outstanding service to you, your families, and communities.

As we mentioned in last year's annual letter, our members have been burdened with higher borrowing costs. Our industry experienced the steepest and largest increase in interest rates since 1983. We did realize some relief last year, with the Fed lowering short-term rates from 5.50 percent (upper limit) to 4.50 percent (upper limit). However, Mainers still face the challenge of high rates and affordability.

On the other hand, our members' savings have been handsomely rewarded. We paid our members a record \$6.3 million in dividends, a \$2.7 million increase over the previous year, or a seventy-five percent increase.

The net profit of your credit union, after deducting all expenses and dividend payouts, fell by \$438 thousand, from over \$1.0 million in 2023 to \$610,000 in 2024. The entire profit was affected by the substantial increase in dividends.

Your credit union maintained a solid financial position throughout the year, with a capital-to-assets ratio of 9.45 percent. The \$287.9 million in assets that your credit union manages is accompanied by \$27.2 million in retained earnings. According to our regulators, seven percent is considered well capitalized, their highest measure. As a local deposit and lending institution, Downeast Credit Union stands very strong.

Members of Downeast Credit Union were able to save more than \$2.2 million in interest by transferring their debts from other banks to ours. We had an excellent year!

With the elimination or reduction of multiple fees in recent years, our membership is saving over \$300,000 annually.

Your credit union contributed more than \$50,000 to neighborhood organizations like schools, food pantries, hospitals, and nonprofits, and our amazing and committed team members volunteered more than 500 hours.

In closing, your volunteer Board of Directors, elected by you, will continue to ensure you are well-served and valued.
